


In 2025, WPLN is going on the road to help aspiring women leaders build confidence, find community, and learn new skills to help them on their leadership journey.



WPLN's Fellowship is an opportunity to leverage the expertise of these young women in marketing and technology, research, event planning, and more. Since its launch, WPLN has invested more than \$200,000 in eleven fellows, eight of which now comprise our new alumni network. We provide a monthly stipped travel to an in-

monthly stipend, travel to an inperson training in DC and other WPLN events, including our annual

National Summit.






