This past year has been full of pivotal moments and milestones for women's leadership. In 2025, Virginia saw two women compete for governor, setting the stage for the state's first woman governor—a breakthrough also achieved in New Jersey this year. Virginia also achieved a new milestone with women now holding 40% of seats in the General Assembly, the highest representation in the state's history. We remain deeply committed to seeing these numbers continue to increase across the country by educating, empowering, and inspiring more center- and right-leaning women to lead in public office at every level, in every state.

At WPLN, 2025 marked a year of innovation and growth, with the addition of new programs and the welcoming of our newest team member, Chief Operating Officer Elizabeth Montgomery. This annual report highlights those major milestones and the impact we've achieved together. I hope you enjoy seeing the stories and numbers that reflect your support in action!

I'm particularly proud of the launch of our first podcast, <u>Tips From the Trail</u>, presenting another way in which we strive to reach women where they are—often on the move. This podcast highlights industry and public leader-led discussions that explore the path to political office from the decision to run to election day. Additionally, WPLN hosted our inaugural <u>Lead in Style</u> event in Kalispell, Montana earlier this year, a program we will bring to cities across the U.S. to help women elevate their professional presence and pursue leadership with confidence. These programs reflect our drive to ensure we are providing relevant and accessible resources to women across the country wherever they are in their leadership journey.

As we look ahead to 2026 and America's Semiquincentennial, we celebrate the achievements of women leaders in America, and accept the challenge to build upon the path they paved by inspiring more women to answer the call to leadership.
